Subject: Complaint against Bishop Mary Taylor of Holston Conference, per Book of Discipline

Dear Bishop Wallace-Padgett,

Two years ago, I filed a related complaint against Bishop Taylor with Bishop Carter, who was then President of the College of Bishops of the SEJ.

The SEJ website does not indicate the current officers of the College of Bishops, so I sent the enclosed complaint to him two days ago. I have also enclosed a related letter to the Chairs of the two most relevant committees in my Church, Concord United Methodist Church in Farragut (near Knoxville) TN.

Thank you for your attention to my concerns. I make the same allegation to you as I did to Bishop Carter - that if you fail or refuse to take the actions necessary to see the Book of Discipline process applied to resolve my concerns, then you are corrupt too. I make the same allegation to you as I did to the two lay leaders in my church - if you fail or refuse to do your duty and I end up being murdered by a mentally unbalanced member of my church, you will bear some measure of responsibility.
